Our school blog

A big welcome back to you all and to the summer term - the last term at BB for our current Y6 children! It's lovely to see you all back safe and well.

We hope to be blessed with some sunshine and warmer days soon. Please remember that your child will need a drinks bottle and a sun hat when the warmer weather does finally arrive and of course sun cream will need to be applied before school.

As you know from your child's school report, it's our duty to report on your child's attendance but we also have to share with you the following information regarding unauthorised absences.

If your child is absent from school without authorisation, you will be committing an offence under the Education Act 1996. We may submit a request to Cornwall Council for a Penalty Notice to be issued, in accordance with Sections 444A and 444B of the said Act. Penalty Notices are issued per liable parent, per child and each carry a fine of £60 if paid within 21 days or £120 if paid after this but within 28 days. Failure to pay the Penalty Notice may result in legal action. Absence not authorised by the school may result in a prosecution in the Magistrates' Court under Section 444(1) or Section 444(1A) of the Education Act 1996, leading to a fine of up to £2,500 and/or a custodial sentence. Cornwall Council may also apply for the costs incurred in taking the matter to Court.

A few reminders for you -

- Please remember to book your child's school lunches by 9.30am each day - you can book for up to a half term at a time which saves a lot of time.
- If you need to book wraparound outside of the bookings window, please inform the office, who will be more than happy to book for you and add the sessions to your ParentPay account.
- Don't forget that extra curricular clubs start next week. If you were expecting a confirmation text for your child's place and haven't received one, please contact: bbr-secretary@rainbowademy.org.uk

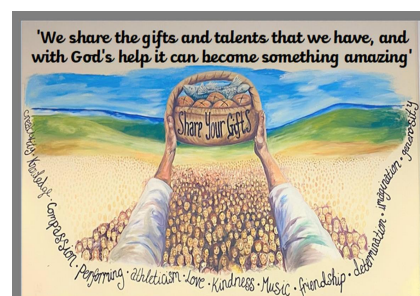


This week we celebrate Gabby, Ghanja, Millie, Sennen, Ruby and Ophelia; our Y6 Netball team.
