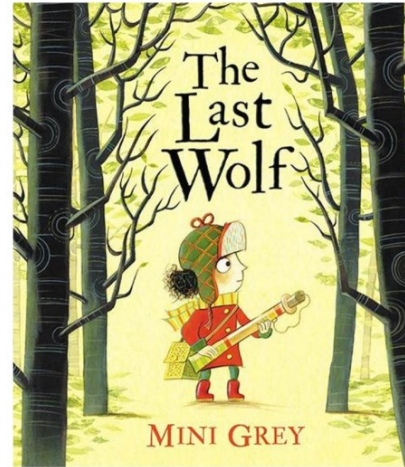



Text: The last wolf by Mini Grey
