The teaching staff spend a lot of time ensuring that each child is placed in the correct class using a number of factors to inform their decisions. Sometimes, from a parents view, from the outside, and without knowing all of these factors, the allocation can seem to be a mistake. However, rest assured that every child and every aspect is looked at in detail and the decisions have been made in each child's best interests to give them the greatest chance to flourish. We are spoilt with highly accomplished teaching professionals and we ask that you trust their judgements in these matters.

We have tried to absorb ever increasing costs, so that they are not passed onto you., However, from the next academic year because of those increasing costs, we have made the difficult decision to raise our prices.
