Oracle Bone	Usually the shoulder bones of animals or the belly shells of turtles. Dug up centuries later by farmers, they were thought to be dragon bones and were ground up to be used in traditional Chinese medicine. In 1889, Wang Yirong and his friend Liu E worked out that the 'dragon bones' had been used in ancient ceremonies.				
Ruler	A person who exercises control or dominion over an area.				
Emperor	A ruler of an empire.				
Ancestors	A person from whom someone else has descended.				
Ideograms	A character symbolising something rather than a group of letters.				
Tomb	An underground area for burying the more wealthy when they've died.

Background Information

During this half-term, we are going to be looking at The Shang Dynasty, a civilisation within Ancient China. - Understand and explain that lots of our historical knowledge comes from archaeological studies of Primary Sources of information.


