## Our School Blog

Welcome back to the second half of the final term for this school year...

As you will see from the list of dates for the summer term included in this newsletter, parent consultations will take place for pupils in Yrs 1-5 on Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> June.

During this meeting your class teacher will let you know which class your child will be assigned to in the next academic year. They will also explain how the transition to this class will be managed and give you the opportunity to discuss any information that you would particularly like passed on to their new class teacher.

Every year a child will express concerns to their parents/carers about their new class, new teacher and friends/peers that are in the same or a different class. This is only natural, as managing feelings about change and moving forward is an aspect of life that all children need. BB teaching staff spend a great deal of time looking at academic ability, friendship groups, learning behaviours, special educational needs and many other factors. This enables your child to be placed into an environment where they will have the best chance of thriving. The decisions behind this might not seem apparent to individual children or indeed parents/carers but we ask that you trust their professional judgement and help support your child to be resilient to any changes.

Children in Rainbows class will automatically join Miss Caff's class as Y1s in September and will receive their end of year reports on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> July. Y6 pupils will have their final parent consultation meeting on Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> July where they will be informed of their SATs results.

Whilst we're on the subject of classes for next year, I'm pleased to advise that Mrs Snell will be returning to BB from her secondment at Grampound with Creed. We are looking forward to her return, although I'm sure she will be greatly missed at Grampound with Creed.

If your child is absent from school without authorisation, you will be committing an offence under the Education Act 1996. We may submit a request to Cornwall Council for a Penalty Notice to be issued, in accordance with Sections 444A and 444B of the said Act. Penalty Notices are issued per liable parent, per child and each carry a fine of £80 if paid within 21 days or £160 if paid after this but within 28 days. Failure to pay the Penalty Notice may result in legal action. Absence not authorised by the school may result in a prosecution in the Magistrates' Court under Section 444(1) or Section 444(1A) of the Education Act 1996, leading to a fine of up to £2,500 and/or a custodial sentence. Cornwall Council may also apply for the costs incurred in taking the matter to Court.
