











motte and bailey castle built from wood




stone keep motte and bailey castle

Key Vocabulary	
Word	Meaning
Castle	A large strong building designed to protect who lived there.
Arrow loop	A narrow vertical slit in the wall where arrows could be fired through
Barbican	Part of the outer defence, defends the entrance
Battlements	At the top of the castle helps protect people
Drawbridge	A bridge that can raised and lowered normally over a moat
Moat	A deep, wide ditch around the castle usually filled with water
Tower	Tall, narrow part of the castle
Portcullis	A strong, heavy, spiked barrier
Motte	A tall, steep mound on which the keep is built
Bailey	Area surrounded by a wooden fence
