

Key Vocabulary	
Word	Meaning
Amphibians	Live in water as babies and on land as adults. They have smooth, slimy skin.
Reptiles	Breathe air and have scaly skin.
Birds	All have a beak, feathers, two legs and wings.
Fish	Live and breathe underwater. They have gills to breathe and fins to swim.
Mammals	Breathe air, grow fur/hair and feed on milk as a baby.
Deciduous	A tree that loses its leaves each year.
Evergreen	A tree that keeps its leaves all year round, even in Winter.
Roots	Take in water and nutrients from the soil and keep the plant secure in the ground.
Stem	Holds the plant up and takes water from roots to leaves.
Leaves	They catch sunlight and help make energy for the plant.
Flowers	Attract insects and birds, made up of colourful petals.
