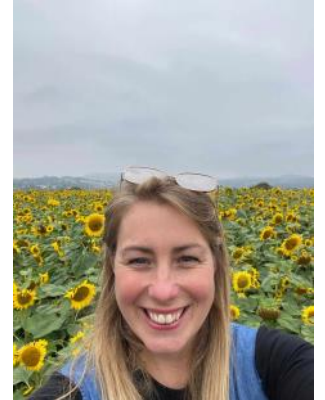

As a part of a new Church of England pilot project, 'Flourish' schools workers are based in 3 schools in the diocese, with a focus on developing a worshipping community and partnerships between the church and families. I am delighted to be working on these roles for a 2 year journey at BB!



I am thoroughly enjoying my time here so far getting to know the children and joining in the festive preparations.

My background is working in special needs education and the NHS, and in church life, leading worship.

We are planning to start a new after school club in January with a focus on creating a reflective space for the children to explore topics of faith in a space they are helping to plan, create and decorate.

Whilst some children have requested a chocolate tasting club and escape room club the space will include some games and chilled activities, a space to chat and catch up with friends and reflect on the day or the week. This space will be shaped by the children as they explore what a worshipping community might look like in an after-school club as we start out on this project.

More details on how to book in for the Flourish club will follow soon!

If your child is absent from school without authorisation, you will be committing an offence under the Education Act 1996. We may submit a request to Cornwall Council for a Penalty Notice to be issued, in accordance with Sections 444A and 444B of the said Act. Penalty Notices are issued per liable parent, per child and each carry a fine of £80 if paid within 21 days or £160 if paid after this but within 28 days. Failure to pay the Penalty Notice may result in legal action. Absence not authorised by the school may result in a prosecution in the Magistrates' Court under Section 444(1) or Section 444(1A) of the Education Act 1996, leading to a fine of up to £2,500 and/or a custodial sentence. Cornwall Council may also apply for the costs incurred in taking the matter to Court.

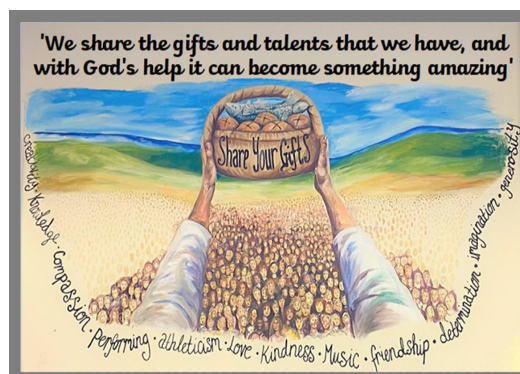
