They got to see a demonstration of how the stretcher is used (thank you Mrs Jackson!), had a go at rescuing a swimming casualty, learnt how to use a wading stick during a rescue and watched how to put on a harness and use ropes for a cliff top rescue. A favourite was a close look inside the truck. A big thanks to our lovely parent for organising this!

Rainbows were so excited with our next visitor on Tuesday, who talked about being a Neonatal Nurse.

The discussion inspired lots of nurse play within our provision and we have had doctors, ambulances and nurses looking after our baby dolls.

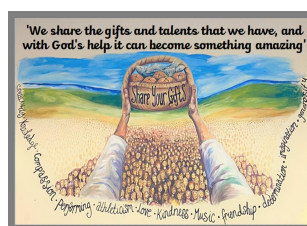
