Nasal Flu Vaccinations

On Wednesday 18th October, Kernow Health will be coming into school to administer this years nasal flu vaccinations. The vaccination is being offered to all children from Reception to Y6.



Further to the letter your child brought home earlier in the week, please remember that the vaccine is offered on an '<u>opt in</u>' basis. This means that if you do not submit a consent form for your child, they will <u>NOT</u> be vaccinated.

Consents need to be submitted by midday on Monday 16th October.


