The weather has started to be a little chillier, especially in the mornings, and perhaps it is a good time to remind everyone of our emergency procedures in case we have any weather-related disruption in the future.

We will always try to make decisions as soon as we possibly can and our format for reporting this will be through Class DoJo and text message. We will also contact the local radio stations (BBC Radio Cornwall) and the Local Authority (Cornwall Council), who will broadcast updates and place them on their websites.

We will always endeavour to remain open to as many pupils as possible but have to weigh up the risks, especially when the advice is not to travel unless it is an emergency. As we have staff from across the county working with us, our decision will be based upon how many are able to arrive safely for work.

Should we be forced to close early during the school day, we will use the same channels of communication and we ask that parents and carers do not phone or message the school with enquiries during this time as that can tie up our phone lines and increase the time we have to get out important information.

Thank you for all your continued cooperation and we hope that we can get through the whole winter without needs to put any of these emergency procedures in place!

If your child is absent from school without authorisation, you will be committing an offence under the Education Act 1996. We may submit a request to Cornwall Council for a Penalty Notice to be issued, in accordance with Sections 444A and 444B of the said Act. Penalty Notices are issued per liable parent, per child and each carry a fine of £80 if paid within 21 days or £160 if paid after this but within 28 days. Failure to pay the Penalty Notice may result in legal action. Absence not authorised by the school may result in a prosecution in the Magistrates' Court under Section 444(1) or Section 444(1A) of the Education Act 1996, leading to a fine of up to £2,500 and/or a custodial sentence. Cornwall Council may also apply for the costs incurred in taking the matter to Court.
