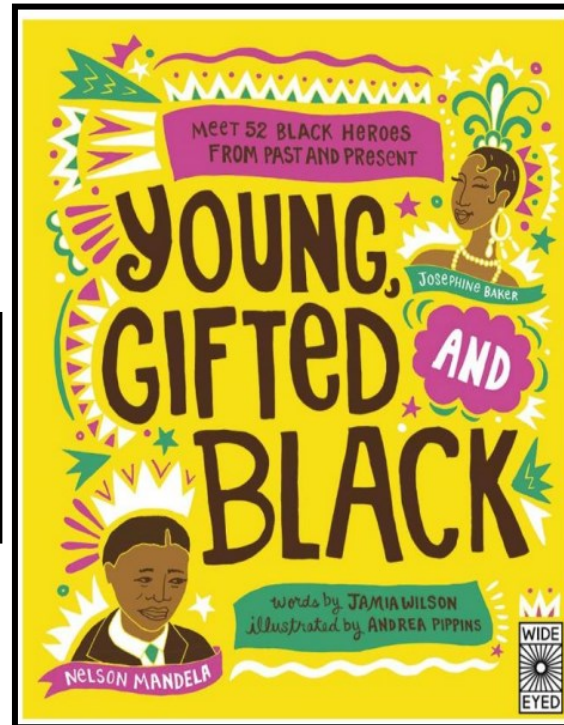

Key Vocabulary

Non-fiction	the content is real and based on truth, rather than made up or created from the imagination.
Biography	an account of someone's life written by someone else.
Hero	a person who is admired for their courage, outstanding achievements, or noble qualities.
Achievements	a thing done successfully with effort, skill, or courage.
Gifted	having exceptional talent or natural ability .



Writing outcome:

To write a series of diary entries about significant events in Matthew Henson's life.

Feature Keys

- Engage the reader through use of description, feelings and opinions.
- Use adverbs and fronted adverbials (with doubt in my mind, anxiously, afterwards).
- Use rhetorical questions to engage reader.
- Use first person (I, we).
- Write in consistent tense including progressive and perfect forms.
- Include the 5Ws – who, what, where, when, why and how.
