## Some of today's fun...

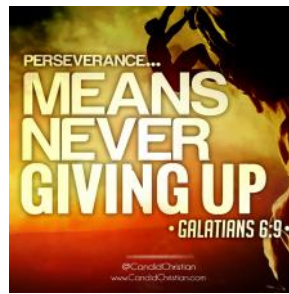
