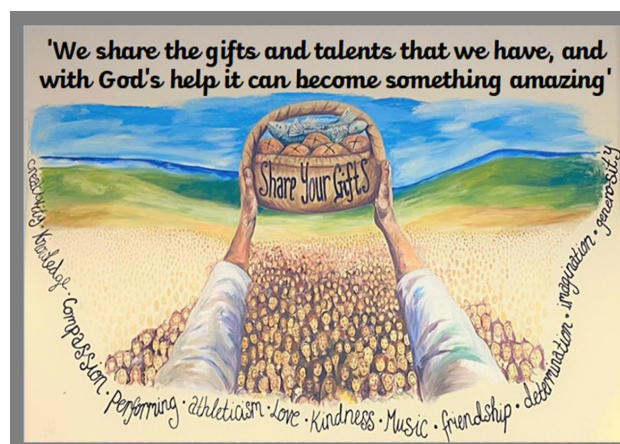

The biggest thank and BB whoop to Mrs Allen, for all your hard work here.



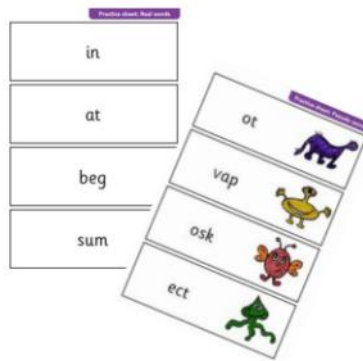
PHONICS SCREENING CHECK INFORMATION SESSION – FRIDAY 28th APRIL AT 3.15PM
