

Our School Blog

Next week marks the half way point of the school year and it has been really encouraging to see the amount of progress the children have made.

In the second half of the year, we look forward to KS2 residentials and an increase in educational visits. The travel costs of these visits are heavily subsidised by BBFriends fundraising. This reduces the amount of money that we ask parents and carers to contribute. The hire of a bus is expensive, and this is increasing year on year, so we are extremely grateful to the volunteers of BBFriends who fundraise for us. (Below is a brief overview of income and expenditure).

Over the last 18 months, between non-uniform days and BBFriends events, a total of £5033. was raised and added to the existing bank balance.

These funds were used as follows:

- Treats (eg sports day lollies, crème eggs, Y6 leavers' parties etc) = £911
- Performances (end of term, Christmas) = £1499
- Transport = £3120
- Author visit = £200

Please continue to support BBFriends events where and when you can as you can see how easily costs mount up.

If your child is absent from school without authorisation, you will be committing an offence under the Education Act 1996. We may submit a request to Cornwall Council for a Penalty Notice to be issued, in accordance with Sections 444A and 444B of the said Act. Penalty Notices are issued per liable parent, per child and each carry a fine of £80 if paid within 21 days or £160 if paid after this but within 28 days. Failure to pay the Penalty Notice may result in legal action. Absence not authorised by the school may result in a prosecution in the Magistrates' Court under Section 444(1) or Section 444(1A) of the Education Act 1996, leading to a fine of up to £2,500 and/or a custodial sentence. Cornwall Council may also apply for the costs incurred in taking the matter to Court.
