



Did you know...
In order to reach their Early Learning Goal, children in Reception need to be able to demonstrate an understanding of what has been read to them by retelling stories in their own words and anticipating key events in stories.

Things to try at home!

Guess what happens next...

Discuss the book while you are reading it.



Ask your child questions like:
What do you think is going to happen next?

Or

How do you think she is feeling now?

Act it out!

During reading or after reading a story, ask your child/children to act out the story! Get involved and act out parts with them.



Story Scramble!

Copy/draw pictures from different parts of the story and muddle them up.

Ask your child to put the story back in the correct order, retelling the story as they go!



Guess the Rhyme!

When reading rhyming books, encourage your child to say the last words of the sentences to predict the rhyme.
