Bruzil	Brazil is the largest country in South America.
Equator	Imaginary line through the middle of the earth that receives the most sunlight.
Physical features	Natural features of the land. E.g. mountain, river.
Human features	Features of the land created by humans. E.g. road, house.
Carnival	An annual festival that involves music and dancing.
Rainforest	A dense forest found in hot areas with lots of rainfall.
Similarity	When two things are the same or have common features.
Difference	When two things are not alike and have no common features.
