


The Holy Spirit	The third person in the holy trinity; the spirit of God
The Kingdom of God	A spiritual realm, where God reigns
Disciple	A follower of Jesus Christ
The Lord's Prayer	The prayer taught by Jesus Christ to his disciples
Resurrection	The rising of Christ from his death
