## Key Vocabulary

Word	Meaning
<b>Brazil</b>	Brazil is the largest country in South America.
<b>Equator</b>	Imaginary line through the middle of the earth that receives the most sunlight.
<b>Physical features</b>	Natural features of the land. E.g. mountain, river.
<b>Human features</b>	Features of the land created by humans. E.g. road, house.
<b>Carnival</b>	An annual festival that involves music and dancing.
<b>Rainforest</b>	A dense forest found in hot areas with lots of rainfall.
<b>Similarity</b>	When two things are the same or have common features.
<b>Difference</b>	When two things are not alike and have no common features.
