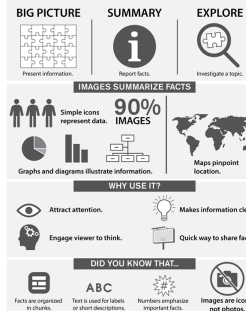

Feature Keys



- Use precise word choices

- Use persuasive language: quotes and rhetorical questions
- Directly appeal to the reader
- Support points using persuasive examples and provide evidence
- Provide well-developed factual information for the reader
- Include a summarising statement
