| Continent           | A very large landmass, usually separated by water or other natural features, like a mountain. |
| Ocean               | A very large area of salt water.  |
| Landmark            | Something that stands out in an area, such as a building, a bridge, a mountain or a lake,     |
| Country             | An independent region within a continent that has its own rules.                              |
| World               | The Earth, together with all its people and continents,                                       |
| Northern Hemisphere | Half of the earth that is north of the equator.   |
| Southern Hemisphere | Half of the earth that is south of the equator.   |
